Dear Stz'uminus First Nation Community Member,

On direction of your Chief & Council, Coast Salish Development Corporation (CSDC) is pleased to inform you of the first distribution of profits from the Coast Salish Development Corporation.

Through business terms of reference, Chief & Council have reserved 20% of CSDC's annual profits go to community projects. These profits are managed by the Kulleet Bay Resource Society through Chief & Council. Annual profits come from the activities from the five companies we operate.

This year, by an order through motion, Chief & Council have allocated 10% of profits directly to members. The remaining 10% will go toward the community's Christmas party as well as much-needed improvements at the Kulleet Bay longhouse.

The \$100 that each of you will receive is meant to be a small measure of thanks from Chief & Council to the community. You gave great support during the Land Designation vote and in other important ways over the past year. We need to move forward together and we are moving forward together.

It is wonderful that the CSDC companies were able to make such substantial profits during such a challenging year. A lot of hard work goes into making these companies successful. We hope and expect profits to rise through the coming years, resulting from support of Land Designation that allows for the Four Corners Development and other opportunities like the Fortis investment.

Chief & Council have also directed that the remaining 80% of CSDC profits be reinvested in our companies. This is so that CSDC remains both strong and profitable in the years ahead. It is truly a 'reinvestment in the future' and our future is looking good.
