Stz'uminus First Nation is seeking a part-time Community Recycling Champion.

The purpose of this position is to offer up to 20 months of part-time employment for a Community Recycling Champion, reporting to the Public Works & Capital Projects Coordinator and working closely with the Recycling Upgrades Plan Team.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- Being a change agent, working with community members to encourage and support positive recycling behaviors and actions;
- Coordinating implementation of the Recycling Upgrades Plan;
- Greeting the Stz'uminus First Nation community in a friendly and professional manner while leading community education initiatives;
- Obtains feedback from members regarding the recycling upgrades;
- Keeps accurate records related to the work;
- Works closely with the Solid Waste and Recycling Worker throughout the duration of the Recycling Upgrades Plan implementation;
- Operates refurbished recycling truck, pallet truck and appliance dollies;
- Assembles and distribute recycling equipment;
- Ensures project planned deadlines and security standards are met;
- Other duties may be required by the direct Supervisor.
- Assists in delivery of emergency services for the Stz'uminus First Nation community.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Completion of Grade 12 preferred
- Must have a valid BC Driver's License and willing to provide a Driver's abstract;
- Criminal Record Check required;
- Must be willing and able to perform physically demanding work;
- Must be willing to take additional training at SFN expense, to broaden knowledge base.
- Knowledge of Stz'uminus traditions and language an asset;
- Experience and/or education related to environmental services planning and work an asset.
