The Stz'uminus First Nation is seeking a Mental Health and Wellness Clinician for a full-time permanent position at the Stz'uminus Health Centre.

The Mental Health and Wellness Clinician works as a member of the overall Health Team and plays a lead role in establishing a community-based mental health program—one that includes addressing critical gaps in mental health services and programs.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:

- A minimum of 2 years of clinical experience working in mental health services with the responsibility for providing a wide range of community-based mental health.
- Knowledge of mental health services - especially child and youth mental health services, including how clients can access these services.
- Experience working or linking with First Nations communities or other Aboriginal communities.
- Able to provide counselling on a broad range of concerns, including male health and mental health issues.

- Licensed to practice nursing in the Province of British Columbia under the British Columbia College of Nurses and Midwives (BCCNM) or a post-graduate (Master's Level) in one of the following disciplines:
