This position is responsible for supporting the operation and maintenance of Stz'uminus First Nation's sewer and water systems.

The Water and Sewer Operator will be working up to **37.5 hours per week**, depending on the department's needs.

Skills & Experience Requirements:

- Knowledge and ability to safely operate basic hand and power tools.
- Knowledge of workplace safety and safe lifting and handling procedures.
- Knowledge and ability to make numeric calculations used in water and wastewater fields.
- Must have good client service skills.
- Must be able to prioritize work in order of importance and urgency.
- Must have practical communication skills - verbal and written.
- Must have the ability to read and interpret drawings, as-built plans, maintenance manuals, material specifications, and similar technical documents.
- Must be honest, trustworthy, and demonstrate sound work ethics.
- Must display sound judgment.

Required Qualifications:

- Experience in Public Works Maintenance is considered an asset.
- Valid BC Driver's Licence and reliable transportation are required.
- WHMIS training or willingness to take as a job requirement.
