The Stz'uminus First Nation is seeking a full-time permanent Mental Health and Wellness Clinician for the Stz'uminus Health Centre.

Hours of work: 35 hours per week, 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. (unless otherwise scheduled to meet the needs of programs) Monday to Friday.

The Mental Health and Wellness Clinician works is a member of the overall Health Team and plays a lead role in establishing a community-based mental health program, including addressing critical gaps in mental health services and programs.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:

- ★ A minimum of 2 years of clinical experience working in mental health services and providing a wide range of community-based mental health services.
- ★ Knowledge of mental health services - especially child and youth mental health services, including how clients can access these services.
