About The Role

Reporting to the Health Manager, the Home Care Nurse combines administrative and direct client care responsibilities. The Home Care Nurse is responsible for providing services such as acute care nursing, client assessments, case planning and case conferencing. Primary clients include Elders, persons with chronic illness or disabilities, and special needs clients. The Home Care Nurse completes home/support assessments of Stz'uminus First Nations clients, collaborates with the client, family, physician and home care team to develop personal care plans, and assigns appropriate resources to meet client needs. The HCN also manages the Home and Community Care Program and utilizes planning, supervision, coordination, communication, team building, and liaison skills.

Qualifications

- Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing with 3 years' experience in Home Care Nursing
- Current registration (RN) as a member in good standing with the Registered Nurses Association of BC (RNABC)
- Current CPR and First Aid Certification
- Two years recent acute Community Nursing
- Valid BC Driver's License
- A successful Criminal Record Check is mandatory
- Knowledge of the Stz'uminus First Nation community, culture and language is an asset
